Day 01 Saturday MEXICO CITY

Arrival at airport and transfer to hotel. Check in and free time.

Day 02 Sunday MEXICO CITY (Pyramids of Teotihuacán and Basilica of Guadalupe)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning visit to the Three Cultures Square, in this place there was the most important market of the Aztec Empire, where people could find a great variety of products that arrived from all cardinal points. The Tlatelolco Tianguis (street market), nowadays known as the Three Cultures Square, owes its name to the fact that the Spaniards built a church on top of an Aztec platform and in modern times many modern residential buildings were constructed around. We will continue our tour to the archaeological site of San Juan Teotihuacan, the “mysterious city of the gods”, to visit the gigantic Pyramid of the Sun – built in the 1st century AD – the Pyramid of the Moon - built in the 2nd century AD – the Avenue of the Dead, the Citadel with its Temple of Quetzalcoatl and the Palace of the Butterflies. **Lunch.** Upon our return to Mexico City we will visit the Basilica of Guadalupe with its modern and old buildings. Rest of the afternoon free.

Day 03 Monday MEXICO - PUEBLA - OAXACA

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards Puebla, World Heritage Site. Panoramic tour highlighting the Armament Square, the Cathedral, the Chapel of the Rosary, the House of the Dolls, the Compañía De Jesús (temple of the Jesuit Order), the University and the Square and Alley of the Toads, House of the Weakling and we will also enjoy free time at the colorful handcrafts center called El Parian. **Lunch.** We will continue to Oaxaca, land of the gold and jade. Overnight.

Day 04 Tuesday OAXACA (Monte Albán, Coyotepec, Teotitlan, El Tule)

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to Monte Alban, the ancient Zapotec capital. We will continue towards the town of Coyotepec, famous for the elaboration of black clay vases and the textile region of Teotitlán del Valle where artisans will show us their weave techniques and how they obtain natural dyes. In the end, we will visit the millennial Árbol del Tule (the stoutest tree in the world). Return to the city of Oaxaca and panoramic tour.

Day 05 Wednesday OAXACA - VERACRUZ (City Tour)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards the Gulf of Mexico to the well-known Port of Veracruz. Arrival at noon. Check in at hotel and free time. City tour in the afternoon: San Juan de Ulúa Fort, Santiago Stronghold, the Lighthouse, Office of Vital Records, its old and busy pier and the modern zone of the city and the Boca del Rio municipality. At night, the bohemianism, the danzón (a Cuban origin dance) and the happy ambience of the “jarochos” (people from the state of Veracruz) invade the Zócalo (main square) and the pier.

Day 06 Thursday VERACRUZ (El Tajín)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to visit the archaeological site of El Tajín “the City of the Thunder God”. It will amaze us with its five zones: the Arroyo Square, Central Zone, the Great Xicalcolihqui, Little Tajín and the Columns Ensemble. Amongst its buildings the Alcoves Pyramid stands out as it has 365 hollows allusive to the solar year and its overhanging cornices, a true marvel of engineering. We return to Veracruz via Tecolutla (free time for lunch) and in the afternoon through the Emerald Coast we return to Veracruz. Overnight.

Day 07 Friday VERACRUZ-XALAPA (Veracruz-Coatepec-Xalapa)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Coatepec, Magic Town, famous for its coffee and orchids. Free time to stroll around and taste its world famous coffee. After, we will enjoy a visit to the Ex-Hacienda "El Lencero" which was the residence of the General Antonio López de Santa (president of Mexico over 22 years in the 1800's). When we arrive in Xalapa, capital of the State of Veracruz, we will visit the Anthropology Museum that preserves many treasures from the Totonaca, Huasteca and Olmec cultures. During the free afternoon there is the possibility to visit the IMAX Theater of the interactive museum, walk along the Promenade of the Lakes, or along the Lakes, backstreets and alleys of its Old Town or even enjoy a concert at the theater. Overnight.

Day 08 Saturday XALAPA – TLAXCALA - MEXICO

Breakfast at the hotel. . Departure towards Tlaxcala. We start with a visit to the Basilica of the Virgin of Ocotlán (a temple with a Baroque interior built in the XVI century) and the Ex-Convent of San Francisco, nowadays the Cathedral, located next to the bullring. We stroll along its beautiful and clean Old Town and end at the Government Palace. Free time. Continuation to Mexico City.

Day 09 Sunday MEXICO

Breakfast at the hotel. At the proper time, transfer to Mexico City's airport, for your departure flight.
